Dr. Lehocky is a plastic surgeon with over 10 years of plastic surgery experience. He is certified by the American Board of Plastic Surgery and a member of the American Society of Plastic Surgeons, which means he has met the highest standards for those in the field of plastic and reconstructive surgery. Dr. Lehocky is one of a select group of highly trained plastic surgeons having degrees in both Medicine and Dentistry along with formal training in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery (the surgical specialty of Dentistry), General Surgery (body surgery), Plastic Surgery and specialty fellowship training in Craniofacial Surgery.

He is a graduate of the University of Notre Dame and trained in Plastic Surgery at two of the premier training programs in the country – Case Western Reserve University and the University of Pittsburgh.

For 6 years he taught plastic surgery of the body and face at Loma Linda University in southern California, where he was also the Director of Craniofacial Surgery. In his teaching practice at Loma Linda, he was involved in helping those with some of the most difficult problems

in plastic surgery including the separation of conjoined twins. He now concentrates his practice in cosmetic plastic surgery of the face, breast and body.

He is the author of several articles on plastic surgery and contributed the chapter on facial evaluation to the new comprehensive textbook Plastic Surgery. He has developed an in-depth knowledge of the face including the factors that contribute to the perception of beauty and the effects of aging.

Dr Lehocky's goals for any patient are the same: to provide the highest quality plastic surgery using the latest techniques and ideas. He strives to achieve a natural look and above all, his primary concern is to perform all surgery safely.
